Inspired by Warhol's colour-block reproductions, Saunders has breathed new life into the original photograph by appropriating the image in a hot pink silk screen.

In 1987, Andy Warhol died due to a heart problem, so for every print and experience sold, the gallery will donate £75 to the British Heart Foundation.

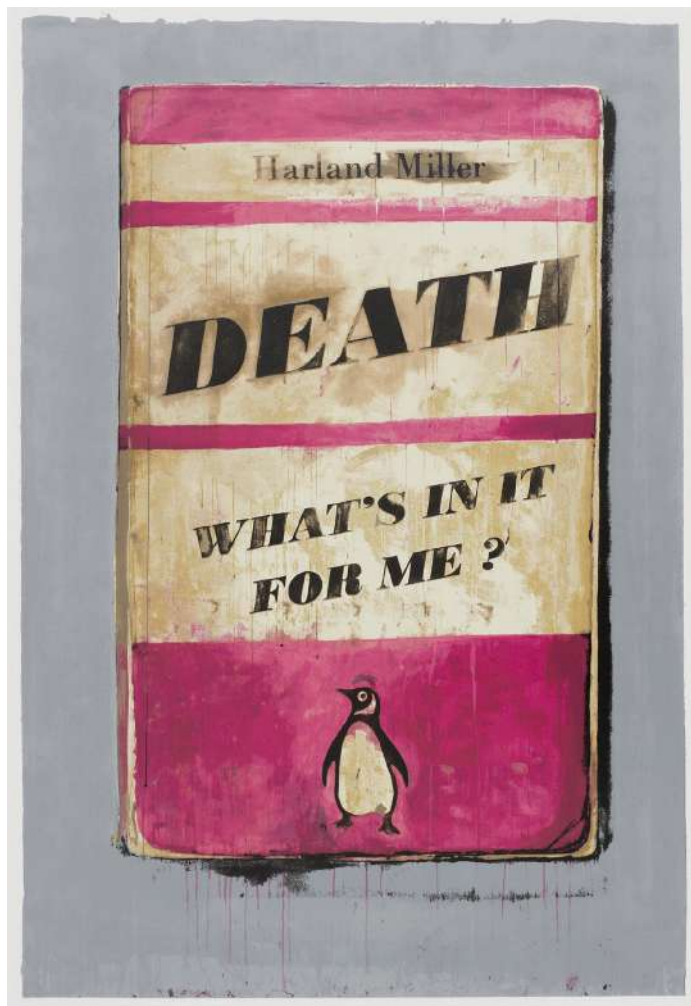

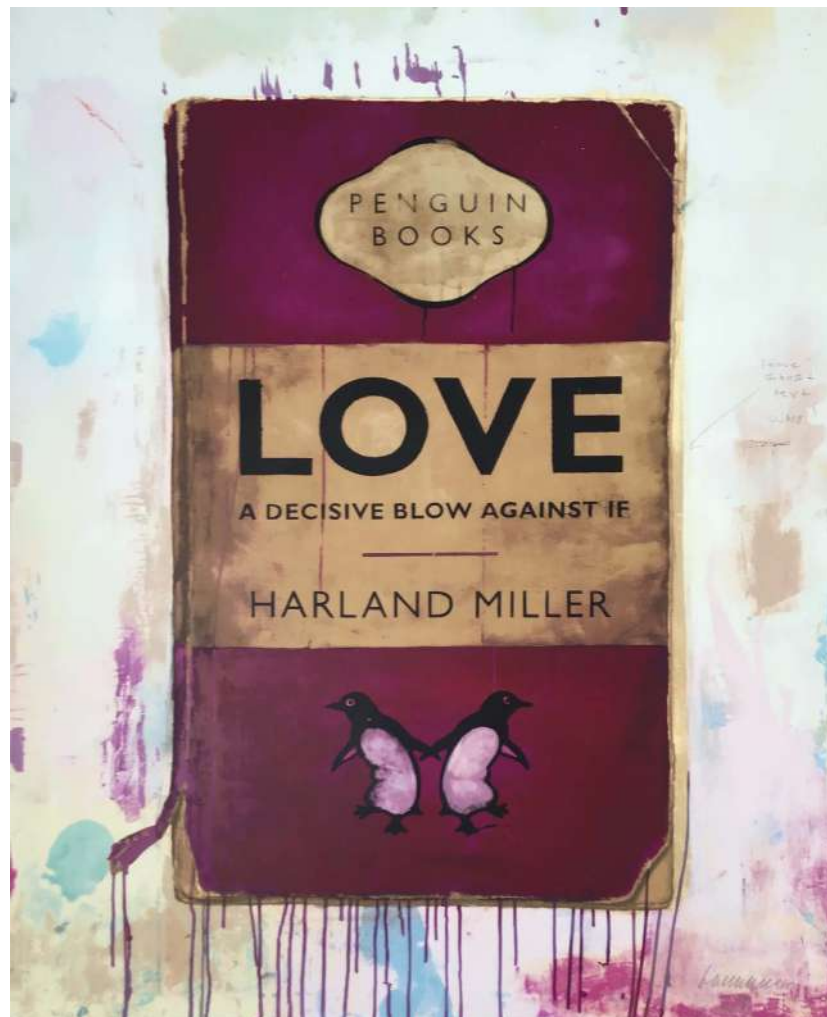
Detail of 'Balloon Rabbit'

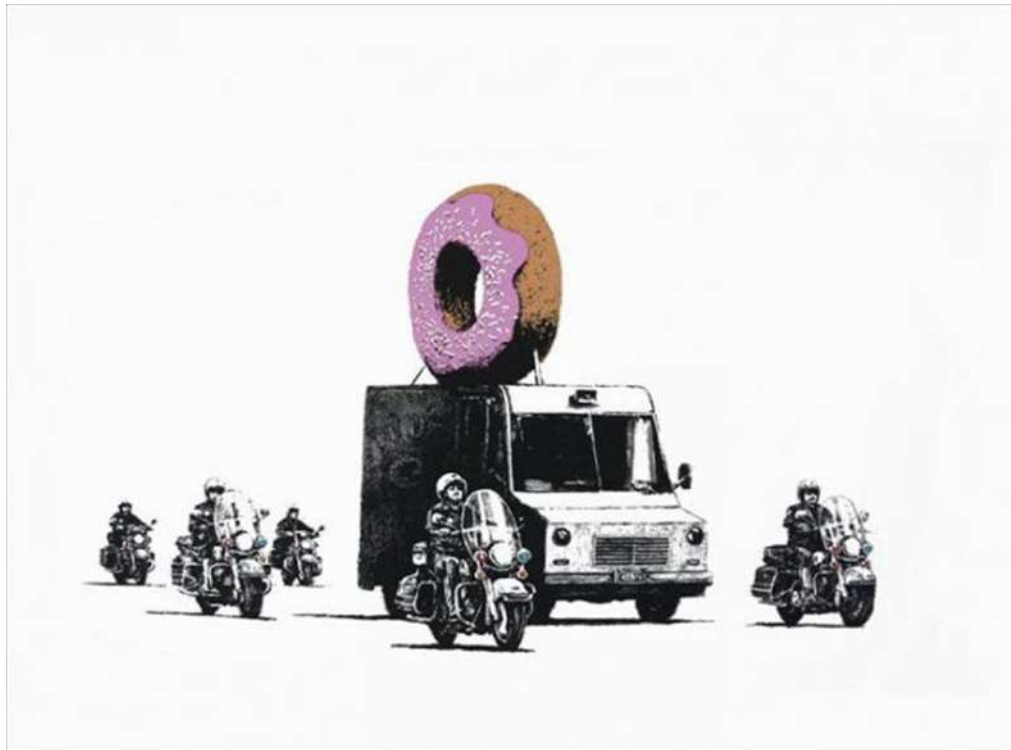

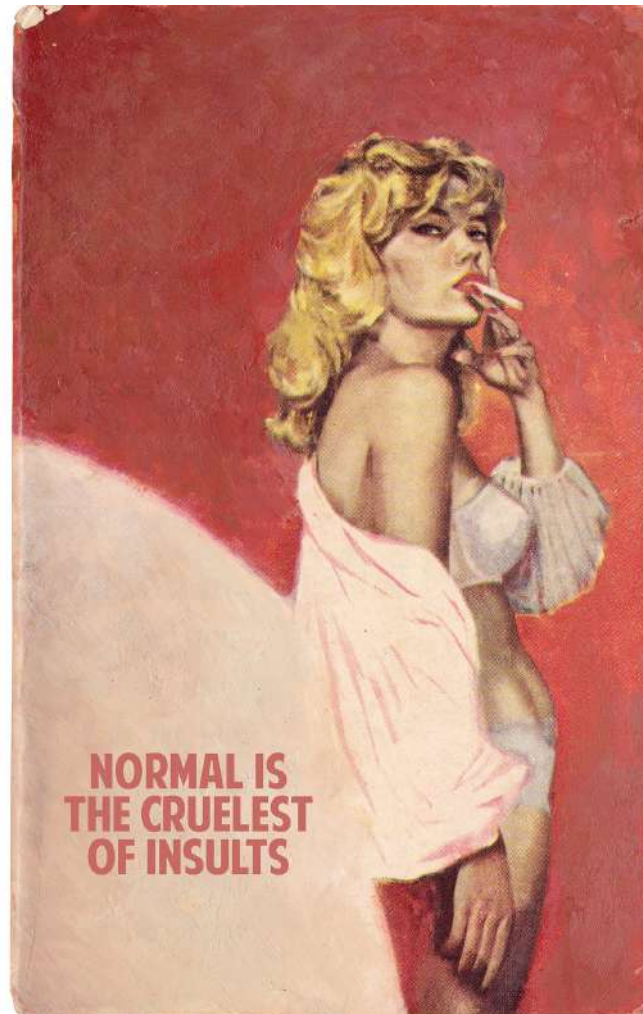
